79% Chardonnay, 14% Viognier, 7% Albarino

LABEL STORY: *These are our blended wines; bold, unconventional and unapologetic. The Tooth & Nail labels are John James Audubon originals; beasts of the early 1830s fighting "Tooth & Nail" to survive. The struggle to survive is real. Audubon finds a poor fox caught in the FRAGRANT SNARE.*

VINEYARD: : *Murmur Vineyard*

South facing sand slope, weathers 25° diurnal shifts, summer sun and bitter winds. Borders the most South Western portion of Santa Maria AVA, 12 miles from the Pacific Ocean. Dynamic varieties, clones, rootstock and innovative farming.

WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES:

Bright, with fresh acidity carrying orange zest, white flower, young pineapple with hints of melon and stone fruit. There is a nice weight to the mid body with flavors of citrus and tropical fruits intertwining throughout the length of the wine. All three varietals harmonize in sync and lead into a clean and refreshing finish.
