LABEL STORY: . *Amor Fati* translates in Latin to “the love of one’s fate.” Aggressive and engulfing, yet showcasing restrained balance on the palate; tannins are lush, round, unprecedented. Labels are sketch renditions of William Blake’s 1793 work “The Marriage Of Heaven and Hell; An Angel watches over the sleeping hero on his journey between Heaven and Hell.

VINEYARD: *Murmur Vineyard*

South facing sand slope, weathers 25° diurnal shifts, summer sun and bitter winds. Borders the most South Western portion of Santa Maria AVA, 12 miles from the Pacific Ocean. Dynamic varieties, clones, rootstock and innovative farming.

WINEMAKER’S TASTING NOTES:

Elegant, both in visual hues, fragrant aromas and texture. This lovely Pinot Noir gives notes of perfectly ripened strawberries, red plum and rose petals. The soft, medium bodied palate is complimented by the natural acidity and graceful tannins which round out the finish. Only 200 cases produced.
